## **NEW SNOW EMERGENCY POLICY**

When a winter storm is predicted, the Mayor or his designated representative may declare a snow emergency. This shall be published any time within 8 hours prior to the predicted start of the winter weather. At this time the Mayor or his representative would notify the local News Stations, Police Dept., Fire Dept., Emergency Management, Road Crew Supervisor and the Borough office. It would then be posted on the Borough website. **Some snow removal suggestions** are when removing snow from the sidewalk or street, do not pile the snow close to the intersection or in the handicapped ramps. Please do not park cars close to the intersections and if possible tuck mirrors in on wider vehicles. The road crew tries to plow curb to curb but this cannot always be done due to parked vehicles or the amount of snow. Snow emergency routes are as follows-

The snow emergency routes are streets marked with permanent signs stating this road is a snow emergency route parking is prohibited during a snow emergency. All vehicles not removed by the time stated will be towed at the expense of the vehicle owner. *REMINDER*-Per Ordinance 222, SECTION 5. It shall be unlawful for any person to remove snow or ice from private property and to put, place or deposit or cause to be put, placed or deposited, snow or ice so removed upon the right of way of any street. Any person violating Section 5 of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, pay a fine or penalty of not less than Twenty—five (\$25.00) Dollars, nor more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars and costs, and in default of payment of fine and costs suffer imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days.
